

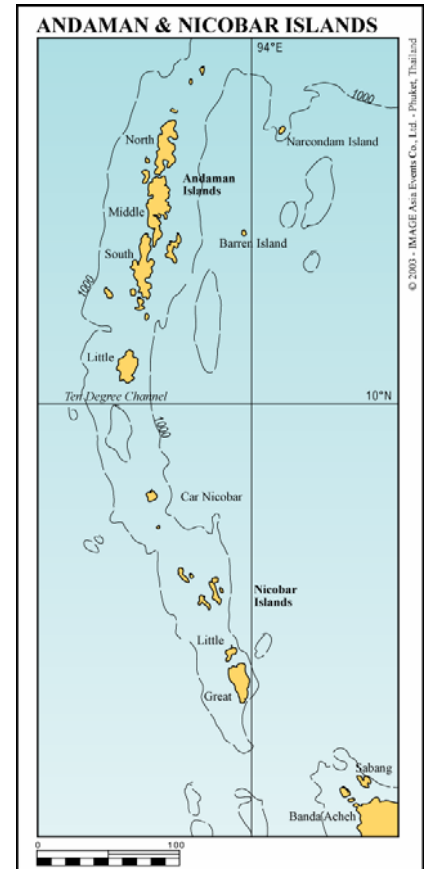


## Andaman Islands 7 Day Example Itinerary

**Day 1** Arrive in Port Blair in the morning & join SY Asia. We depart Port Blair and sail south through McPhearson Strait and to the remote Twin Islands. Evening fishing trip followed by fresh fish BBQ. Magnificent sunset views. Just 15 miles away to the north west is an island (off limits) inhabited by a cannibalistic tribe who has never had any contact with the outside world.

**Day 2** Morning snorkeling at Twin Islands. The shallow sandy channel between the islands is fringed with pristine coral reef and frequented by giant manta rays. These mantas have had little human contact and are completely unafraid. They closely investigate snorkellers and our dingy.

Afternoon sail to uninhabited Cinque Island which has some of the finest beaches in the world. These beaches are important nesting sites for leatherback turtles in the Indian Ocean.



**Day 3** Morning snorkeling or fishing trip in the pristine waters around Cinque Island. Afternoon walk on Cinque Island with wild deer, monitor lizards and a superb viewpoint to watch the sunset.

**Option:** Scuba diving at nearby "Fish Rock" with a good chance of seeing sharks, eagle rays, manta rays or whale sharks.

**Day 4** Sail south to Brother Island – the perfect castaway island. This island is surrounded by miles of shallow coral reef and sandbanks. The nearest human habitation is more than 100km away.

**Day 5** South Brother island is covered in impenetrable jungle which gives way to tall shady trees at the water's edge. The surrounding reefs are a favorite hunting ground for the huge dolphin population in this area. Morning fishing/exploring/snorkeling trip followed by a lunchtime seafood BBQ on the beach under shady casuarina trees.

Afternoon sail south to Little Andaman Island.



**Day 6** The west coast of Little Andaman Island is a superb wilderness area with miles of wild jungle fringed by a white sand beach and coral reef. The many large estuaries along this coastline are ideal for fishing, bird-watching and spotting salt water crocodiles. There is also some fascinating jungle walking in this area.



Great afternoon sailing back north to Sisters Islands – a pair of coral atoll islands with superb beaches and miles of idyllic shallow reef for snorkeling.

**Day 7** Morning snorkeling & swim at Sisters Islands then sail back to Port Blair.



***This itinerary hardly starts to scratch the surface of the Andaman Islands. We have not yet been to see the elephants of Interview Island, the surf breaks and the jungle wilderness of the west coast or the spectacular live volcano of Barren Island.***
